Position Summary

Paqtnekek Mi'kmaw Nation is seeking a reliable and experienced Fleet Supervisor to support the operations of the Paqtnekek Fisheries. Reporting to the Fisheries Director, the Fleet Supervisor will be responsible for overseeing the day-to-day condition and readiness of vessels, gear, and wharf operations. This position plays a key role in ensuring that the fleet is properly maintained, organized, and operating safely and efficiently throughout the fishing season.

Key Responsibilities

- Supervise and coordinate maintenance and readiness of Paqtnekek fishing vessels
 - Monitor and maintain fishing gear and related equipment
 - Assist with organization and operations on the Paqtnekek wharf
 - Ensure vessels and equipment meet safety and operational standards
 - Coordinate repairs and maintenance as required
 - Maintain inventory of gear and equipment
 - Support the Fisheries Director with fleet-related logistics and operational needs
 - Ensure a safe working environment and follow all relevant safety protocols
